Chairman Freeman convened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. with a quorum of four of five board members and welcomed the Board Members and the Management Team to the Property Tax Appeal Board Meeting.

2. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

Mr. Steffen motioned to approve the Board Minutes of March 19th, 2024, as presented. Ms. Buckley seconded the motion, and it carried 4-0.

- b. Mr. Bilotta made a motion to deny the 90-day extension request and proceed to notify the Board of Review based on the evidence filed. Mr. Steffen seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
- c. Mr. Bilotta moved to grant the motion for substitution of counsel and deny the motion for an extension. Ms. Buckley seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
- d. Mr. Steffen moved to grant the motion to vacate default and accept the two intervening districts' adoptions of the Board of Review evidence. Ms. Kinion seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
- e. The Board recognized Mr. Andre, who represented the taxpayer, GE-Hitachi. Mr. Andre offered his opinion that the taxpayer would support the motion as there are complex issues with the 2021 and 2022 appeals, and the resolution of those cases would give quite a bit of guidance on how they would proceed in 2023.
 - Ms. Kinion moved to continue this matter to the May 2024 board meeting, requesting that the appellant appear before the board to present their motion. Mr. Steffen seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
