Mr. Bilotta convened the meeting at 10:03 a.m. and welcomed the Board Members and the Management Team to the Property Tax Appeal Board Meeting. Mr. Steffen motioned to allow Chairman Freeman to attend the meeting remotely. Ms. Buckley seconded the motion, which carried 4-0.

Mr. Ericson contended that the county's motion should not be considered, as they had determined his appeal should be dismissed because it was "not immediately succeeding" a year after the appellant received a favorable PTAB decision. However, the appellant is unable to find a statute supporting the county's claim. Therefore, the PTAB should revert to a plain reading of the statute, which states, 'subsequent year or years.' The appellant believes there is no basis for not reading the statute this way.

Mr. Bilotta moved to grant the motion to dismiss. Ms. Buckley seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.

- c. Mr. Steffen moved to grant the motion to stay the 2024 appeal pending the resolution of the 2022 and 2023 appeals. Ms. Kinion seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
- d. Mr. Steffen moved to grant the motion to vacate and reinstate the appeal to reflect the amended assessments. Mr. Bilotta seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.
